



**Brazil/ABNT REPORT
to the
29th Meeting of ISO/TC 20/SC13
sponsored by
National Aeronautics and Space Administration NASA
Reston, VA, U.S.A.
27 October 2005**

The following ISO originated documents were processed for polling by ABNT, so far, in the current year: ISO/DIS 22670 and ISO/DIS 22663. Others may naturally be under way.

The Commission of Study ABNT/CB08/SC01/CE06 continues its work in transforming ISO/TC20/SC13 originated standards into Brazilian, ABNT standards. Currently, the OASIS standard ISO 14721:2003 - Space data and information transfer system -- Open archival information system -- Reference model is under the ABNT pertinent Commission of Study for internal review process. It will be followed by the final, open review by ABNT Secretariat, for desirably becoming a NBR, i.e., a Brazilian standard.

ABNT continues to look forward toward the unfolding of the planning which aims toward a future integration of ISO/TC20/SC13 and ISO/TC20/SC14 Subcommittees into a joint initiative that may, exclusively or dominantly, be dedicated to the standardization of Space System. It is understood that such a drive will continue to follow a procedure that, among other aspects, may be under the basic guidance of the ISO Technical Management Board (TMB).
