

Italy report to 31st ISO TC20/SC13 Meeting (January 2007)

The Italian Organization for Standardization

- UNI - Italian National Standards Body – (www.uni.com) is a private association founded in 1921 appointed by the Italian government and the European Union to develop, approve and publish technical standards in all economic sectors (industry, trade and services) except for the electric and electrotechnical ones
- UNI manages cooperation and technical assistance projects with other European and non-European NSBs
- UNI represents Italy at CEN and ISO level
- UNI is responsible for coordinating Italian participation in ISO and, in particular, in TC 20/SC 13 and TC 20/SC 14
- Standardization is performed “inside UNI” by 57 technical commissions and “outside UNI” by 14 associated bodies (Enti Federati) to which specific sectors are delegated
- UNAVIA is the associated body (Ente Federato) of UNI for the standardization in the AeroSpace Sector
- UNAVIA is the Association for the Standardization and the Education and Training in the AeroSpace Sector
- UNAVIA gives also the National Focal Point for the European standardization activities of ASD-STAN (associated body of CEN for the AeroSpace Sector)

The Italian representative to the ISO TC 20/SC 13 meetings is proposed by UNAVIA and nominated by UNI. The CCSDS MC ASI delegate has been nominated by UNI as Italian representative to this 31st meeting, and reports to and interfaces with UNI / UNAVIA.
