

ISO TC20/SC13 Draft RESOLUTIONS from the **32nd** International Organization for Standardization (ISO) Technical Committee (TC) 20 Subcommittee (SC) 13 on Space data information transfer systems **Meeting - Darmstadt, 08 October 2007:**

SC13-R-2007-10-1	In view of the recent correspondence, related to CCSDS, ISO TC20/SC13 and SC14 joint cooperation effort and, due to the natural, close affinity between ISO TC20/SC13 and CCSDS, since the inception of ISO TC20/SC13, both organizations are determined to define and maintain a common policy which may guarantee an effective cooperative action between them and ISO TC20/SC14.
SC13-R-2007-10-2	As a result of its recent correspondence with ISO TC20/SC14 and CCSDS, ISO TC20/SC13 resolves to proceed with its cooperation work with both organizations under an increasingly comprehensive methodology that may end up serving as a regular resource in support to the processing of the liaison work among the three organizations. In such a role, it is expected that the mentioned methodology may be validated and maintained as the result of a practical procedure that may instrument the terms of cooperation which are already celebrated by the three mentioned parties under Ref. N405/SC13-N530/SC14, as of August 2007, entitled “Agreement for Definition of a Joint Work Procedure for Identification and Exploration of Liaison Work Related to ISO Standards in Space Systems”.
SC13-R-2007-10-3	ISO TC20/SC13 resolves, in view of his re-assignment to other professional duties, to thank Mr. Neil Dissinger in recognition for his competent, dedicated and certainly significant work to the Secretariat of Subcommittee ISO TC20/SC13.
